What we will do in school...

Science

We will plant different seeds, to water them and observe them grow. Look at lifecycles of frogs, butterflies.

We will explore how we have changed as we have grown up.

Send to school photographs of your child as a baby, toddler, 4 year old, 6 years etc.

Look through photographs of your family

Literacy

We will be reading a book called 'Noisy Town' which is based on transport and differences places found in towns.

Observe different types of transport when they are out in the community.

Share stories and look for different places found in a town. Look at the pictures together.

Art

We will be using apples to create pictures of caterpillars, make cupcake case flowers. We will use our finger tips to paint pictures of flowers.

Paint pictures of different types of transport and to colour in pictures of flowers.

Fold paper to make a butterfly picture.

PSHE

We will be supporting pupils with sharing and recognising when it is their turn. Play lotto games together with peers. Go to the shops to find items from a shopping list.

Play simple board games and take it in turns during activities. Support your child to find items needed in shops and cafes.

Maths

We will practice counting up to 5-10; recognising written numbers to 10 and sequence numbers accurately.

Count things together - how many cars can you see, how many buses can you see? Count how many things you are buying from the shops.



Swimming - every Thursday

Beech Group will be going swimming at Wolverton Pool on Thursdays. Please send your child into school every Thursday with:

- a swimming costume/trunks
- a towel
- in a bag that is large enough for them to put all their clothes into.



PE - every Monday and Wednesday
