Dear Parent,

We hope you have had a lovely Easter break and are ready for the busy final term ahead.

In this flyer you will find information about some of the topics we will be working on this term, and ways in which you can support their learning at home.

Our topic this term is **Growing and Changing**.

What we will do in school...

What you could do together at home...

Topic

We will be learning about life cycles this term as well as identifying the names of animals and their offspring. We will be learning about plants, labelling parts of a flower and growing our own plants.

Observe the changes of the seasons. Look out for new life for example lambs, chicks. Plant seeds and watch them grow.

Literacy

We will be focussing this term on writing. We will be learning how to form sentences, learning how to structure sentences correctly and focussing on correct letter formation.

Write in your child's home-school book to let us know what they have done over the weekend.

Make sure the children are using a full sentence to communicate. Ask them to tell you what they see. Encourage your child to write their name.

Art

We will be using paint this term to create different effects based on the seasons. We will be creating tree pictures throughout the different seasons.

Identify and recognise changes in the environment for example leaf colour.

PSHE

We will continue to help the children to take turns and build relationships with their peers as well as recognising their feelings.

Play turn taking games at home.

Encourage sharing at home. Ask the children how they feel.

Maths

We will begin to tell the time focusing on O'clock initially. We will be learning about the odd one out in a pattern as well as learning about comparative language.

Look at clocks in the house, discuss the time.

Talk about things which are smaller, bigger. Build small or tall towers. Is the car going down the ramp fast or slow?
