Dear Parent,

We hope you have had good Easter break. In this flyer you will find information about some of the topics we will be working on this term, and ways in which you can support your child's learning at home.

Our topic this term is Land, Sea and Air.

What we will do in school...

What you could do together at home...

Science

We will be looking at different means of transport, why boats float and which materials can sink. We are going to recognise different sounds that are made by a range of vehicles.

When you go into the community with your child, please will you point out different means of transport and name them.

Literacy

Linking to our topic we are looking at books related to transport and we will be trying to make our own book about transport now and in the past.

Write in your child's home-school book to let us know what they have been doing in the evenings and weekends.

Share stories and look for different items and characters. Encourage your child to identify specific objects.

Art and DT

We will be creating pictures and crafts around our Land, sea and air theme.

To paint pictures together using different materials e.g. crayons, paints, stencils, ink stamps.

Support your child to mix ingredients, make cakes and biscuits together which can be car shapes.

PSHE

We will be learning how to cross the road safely.

Encourage your child to access the community and become increasingly aware of their surroundings.

Maths

We will practice ordering, sequencing numbers and counting objects. We will explore money and time and number value.

Use maths related vocabulary such as time, coins, money, how many.....

Use language related to time and money and number e.g. count how many apples/pears are in the bag. Say to your child it is twelve o'clock time for lunch

- in a bag that is large enough for them to put all their clothes into.



Please send a PE kit (any comfortable shorts, jogging trousers, jumper and T-shirt) in a bag to keep in school. We will send it home every half-term for you to wash.



Please send in a set of spare clothes for your child.



We will write in your child's home school book everyday so you know what your child has been doing each day and how they have been. We will put letters in your home school book. So please look through it every day.

Please write to us regarding how your child has been at home and if you have any concerns, also inform us of any information that you think we should be aware of such as illnesses, eating and sleep patterns, bowel movements or achievements and progress that your child has made.
